PARTICIPATION IN LSR CLASS XXXIV INCLUDES MANDATORY ATTENDANCE AT:

- A. A two-day mandatory overnight retreat and orientation to be held September 14-15, 2017.
- B. At least eight of the ten full-day sessions, all held on a Thursday. (*Note: Supplementary "pre-tours" and activities are offered in advance of each session. These tours are highly recommended.*)
- C. Year-end retreat held on June 14, 2018.
- D. A commitment to help assist with two or more class days for LSR Class XXXV and attending three leadership development courses during 2018-2019.
